'ABOVE REPROACH'


Blameless

Important Differences

- Deacons aren't responsible for the general oversight of the church (3:5)
- Deacons don't have to be able to teach (3:2)


*Also no requirement noted for deacon hospitality or for elder's wives (3:2,11)







The word can mean "trustworthy" (1 Tim. 3:1,11) or "believers" (1 Tim. 4:12)




